

ENGL 3960W Seminar and ENGW 3960W Workshop Application

Course Prerequisites:

- Declared English major. (Priority for EngW 3960W goes to English majors with the Creative Writing minor. Creative Writing minors without the English major will not be offered a space until the end of Spring 2019.)
- Grade of at least C- in EngL 3001W or 3001V. If you have EngL 3001W in progress but expect to graduate in Fall 2019, please apply by the deadline so that a space may be reserved for you.

Additional considerations for admission:

- Priority will be given to applicants who will graduate in the term in which the seminar is offered and who have completed the majority of the major requirements.
- Creative writing applicants are expected to have completed EngW 3104 (or equivalent experience) or other 3xxx poetry writing class.
- Poetry writers planning for Spring or Summer 2020 graduation are welcome to apply for the Fall 2019 poetry workshop, EngW 3960W. We will not offer a poetry workshop in Spring 2020.

Required Application materials:

- Completed application form, including Major Program Audit AND college adviser signature.
- Creative writers must also submit a writing sample of 6 poems. Email your samples to rdrake@umn.edu.

Fall 2019 capstone applications are due in 227 Lind by 4:00 pm on March 28

- **If you apply on time, you will receive a response by April 10.** The Fall 2019 queue begins April 11.
- Your major adviser approval hold will be removed when you are assigned to a capstone course.
- Late applications will be accepted, but the response may be delayed. Capstone assignments will be made on a space-available basis.
- Students graduating Spring 2020 or later will not be offered a seat in EngL 3960W until the end of Spring 2019.
